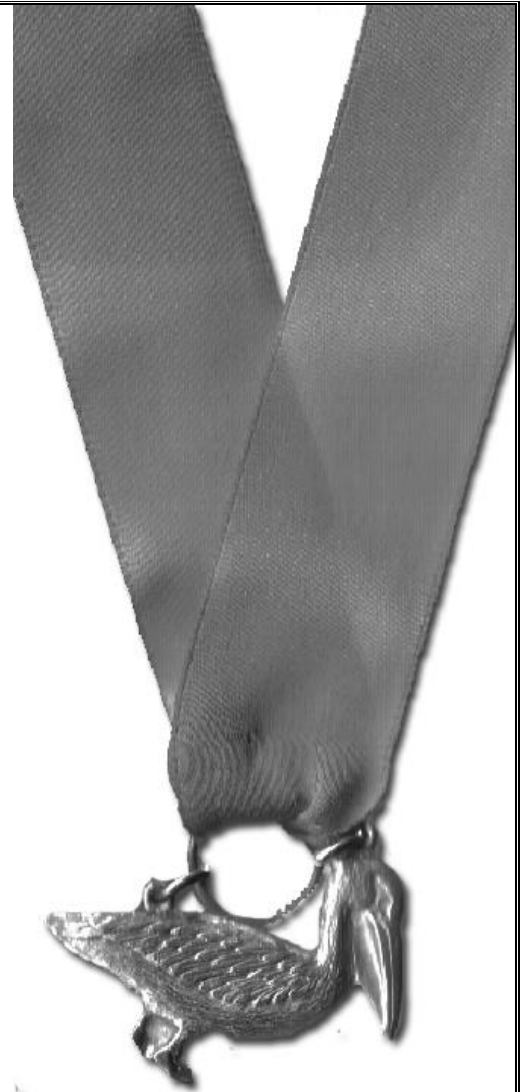


SILVER PELICAN NOMINATION FORM

THE PURPOSE OF THE AWARD

“Awarded since 1929, the Silver Pelican Award is presented annually by the Times Picayune by the Boy Scout who, in the opinion of the Southeast Louisiana Council, has contributed most to the advancement of Scouting (Boy Scouting and/or Cub Scouting) in the Southeast Louisiana Council...”



WHILE ALL NOMINATIONS ARE ACCEPTED FOR SCOUTS WHO MEET THE CRITERIA, BEING UNDER THE AGE OF 18 AT THE TIME OF SELECTION, IT IS HIGHLY DISCOURAGED FOR PARENTS TO NOMINATE THEIR SONS FOR THIS AWARD. NOMINATIONS ARE OFTEN TIMES BEST RECEIVED, AND COMPLETE A CLEARER PICTURE, IF THE NOMINATOR IS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS WORKED WITH THE APPLICANT ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS IN SCOUTING. THESE PEOPLE OFTEN TIMES KNOW THE YOUNG MAN'S TRUE CHARACTER WHEN NO ONE IS WATCHING...

IN ADDITION TO THIS FORM, PLEASE INCLUDE TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION FROM SCOUTERS WHO HAVE WORKED WITH THIS YOUNG MAN IN THE VARIOUS LEADERSHIP ROLES DETAILED IN THIS APPLICATION.

ONE LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION SHOULD BE FROM THE NOMINATOR EXPOUNDING ON HOW THIS YOUNG MAN'S LEADERSHIP HAS POSITIVELY IMPACTED THE SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA COUNCIL'S PROGRAM (CUB SCOUTING, BOY SCOUTING, AND CAMP).

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION SHOULD BE ONE AND A HALF PAGES TYPWRITTEN AND PAINT THE COMMITTEE A CLEAR PICTURE OF THE YOUNG MAN'S CHARACTER, HIS LEADERSHIP ABILITIES, AND WHY HE SHOULD BE SELECTED AS THIS YEAR'S SILVER PELICAN AWARD RECIPIENT.
